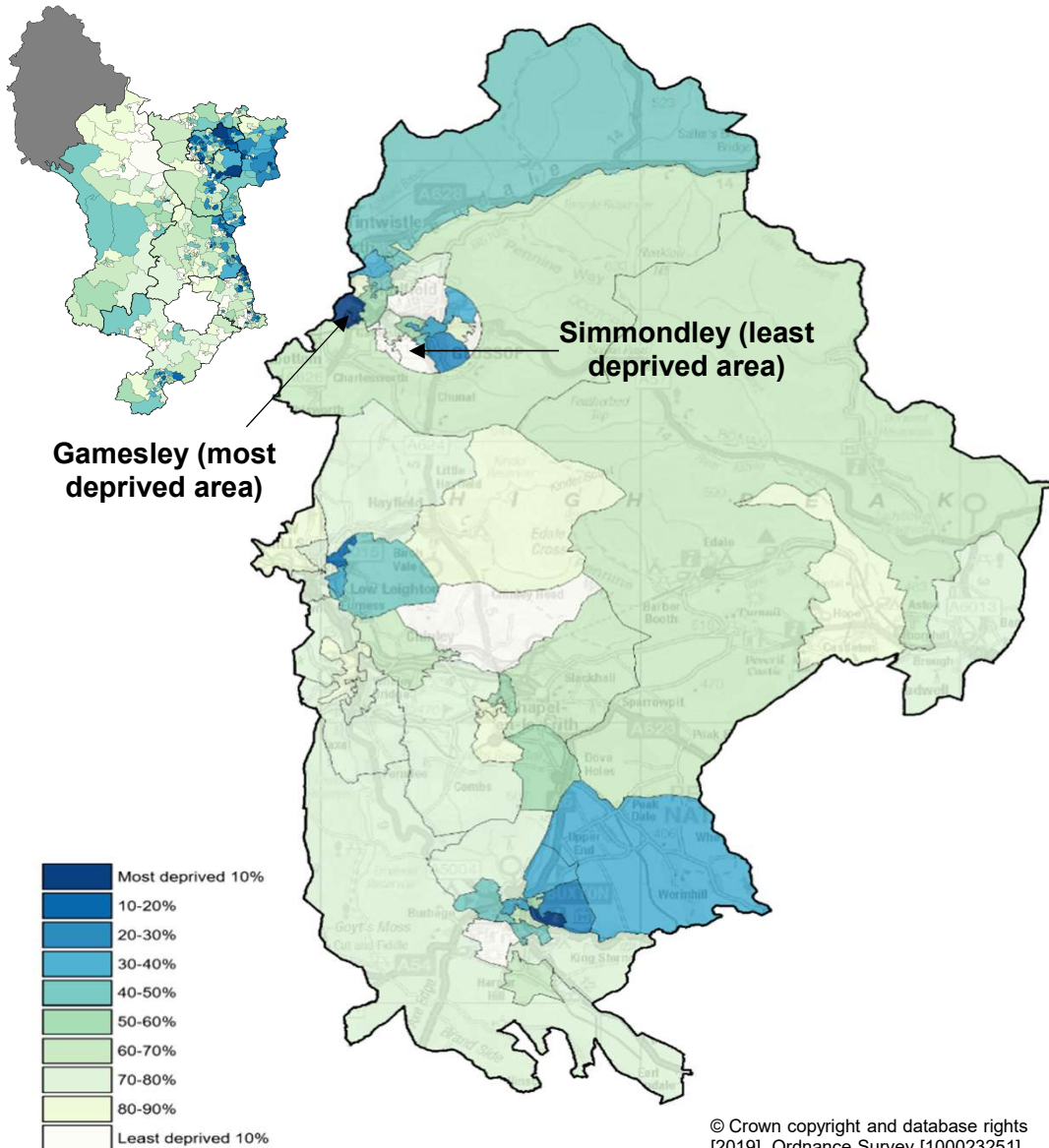


Deprivation in High Peak

High Peak district contains towns such as Glossop, Buxton, New Mills, Whaley Bridge and Chapel-en-le-Frith. 12% of Derbyshire's population live here, which is approximately 92,000 people.



Derbyshire's **3rd** least deprived district. Ranked 202 of 316 local authority districts.

3 of 59 areas are in the most deprived 10% nationally, and **4** in the most deprived 20%.

Worst ranked areas in High Peak:

- 1 - Gamesley South
- 2 - Gamesley North
- 3 - Fairfield

Areas of concern:

- Barms
- New Mills East
- Tintwistle
