
Adult skills levels in Derbyshire



The qualification levels of Derbyshire's working age population (aged 16-64 years) have greatly improved over the last ten years since 2009 when the proportion of people qualified to NVQ Level 4+ was 26.0% and 9.6% of people had no qualifications. Currently 33.8% of the county's residents have a level 4 qualification and just 5.3% have no qualifications.


Qualifications levels over time (%)



However, there continues to be a significant skills gap at level 4+ with relatively fewer Derbyshire residents with higher level qualifications compared with England.

The proportion of the workforce qualified to level 4+ varies by nearly 26% points across the county, from 44.7% in High Peak to 19.1% in Bolsover.

Fewer Derbyshire residents work in higher level occupations than across England

The occupational profile of Derbyshire's firms is lower than for Derbyshire residents reflecting the county's different industrial structure
