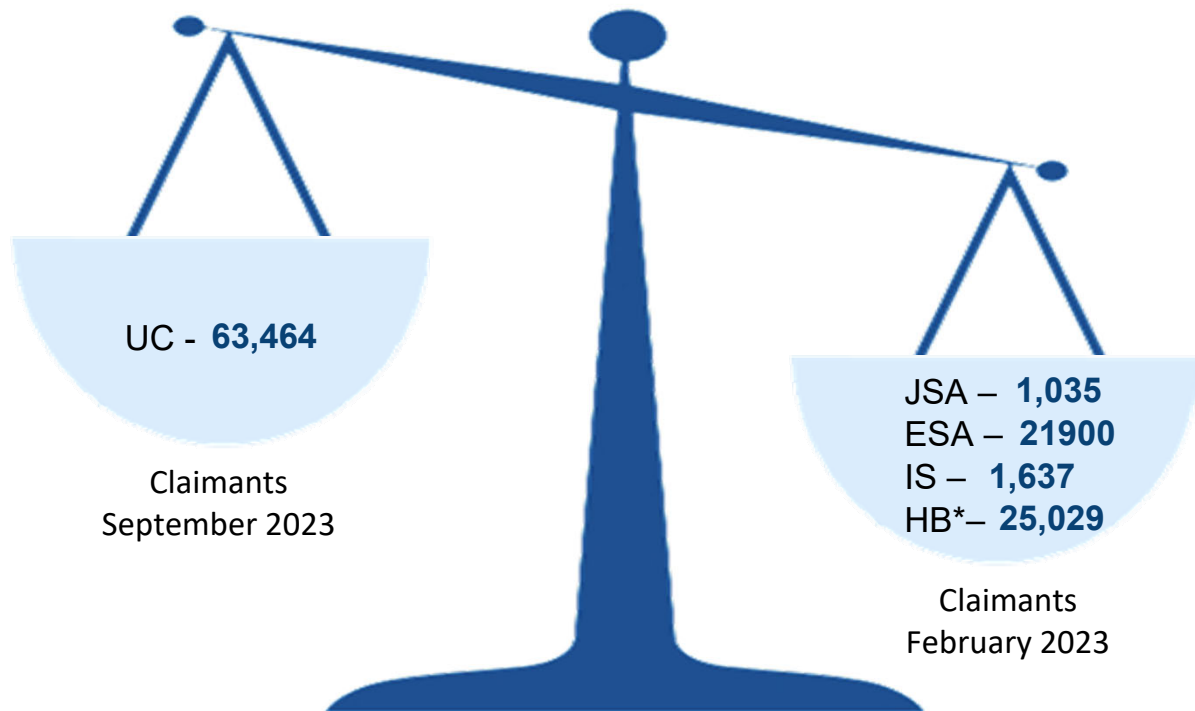


# Universal Credit in Derbyshire

Universal Credit (UC) was introduced in 2013, and replaced the following benefits and tax credits for working aged people who are out of work or on a low income:

- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income Support (IS)
- Child Tax Credit (CTC)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Housing Benefit (HB)
- Working Tax Credit (WTC)

All new claimants are now placed on UC, and all claimants of existing benefits will move onto UC by end of 2024/25.



Annual tax credit data for 2022 shows - **10,000** CTC claimants and **7,000** on WTC.
