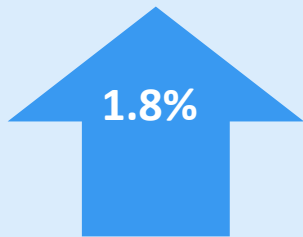
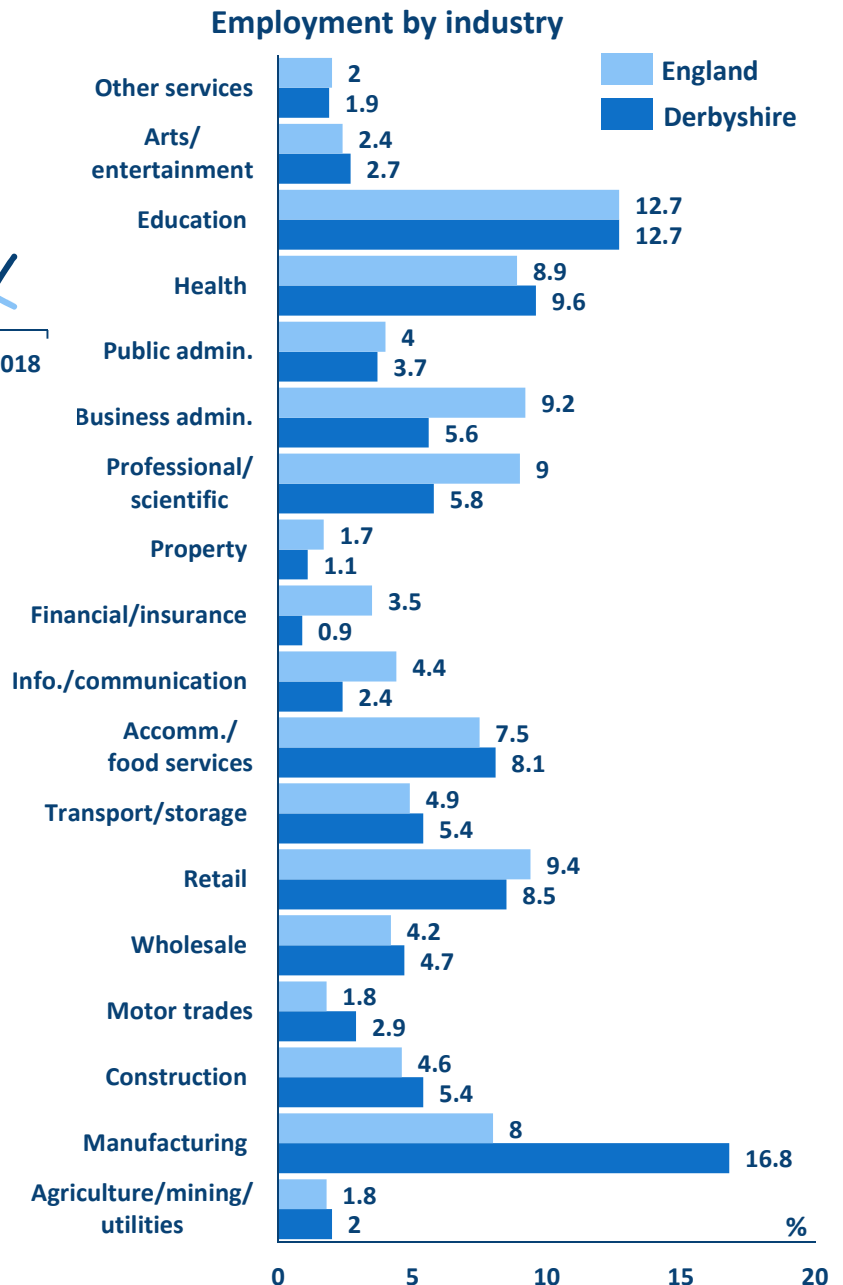
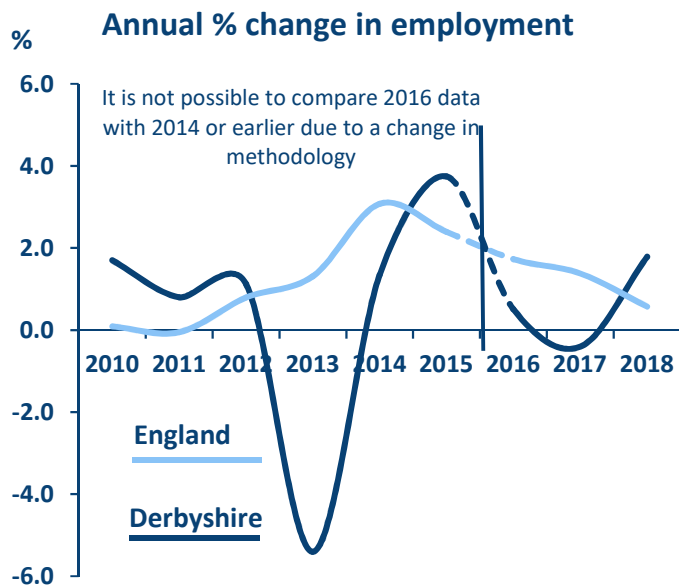


Employment in Derbyshire

295,644 employees in Derbyshire in 2018



There has been an increase in employees (5,200) since 2017, led by a rise in the arts/entertainment/recreation and business administration sectors. However, there has been a decline in manufacturing and health employment



Employment growth in the county has risen in 2018 compared with a slight fall nationally

The dip in employment in 2013 locally was due to the loss of 18,200 public sector jobs, and took employment below that seen after the 2009 recession

Chesterfield has experienced growth (of around 2,100 employees) over the last year, with Erewash and Derbyshire Dales also faring well

However, in Bolsover and Amber Valley there have been falls of 1,000 and 900 respectively over the last year
