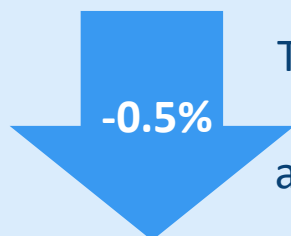
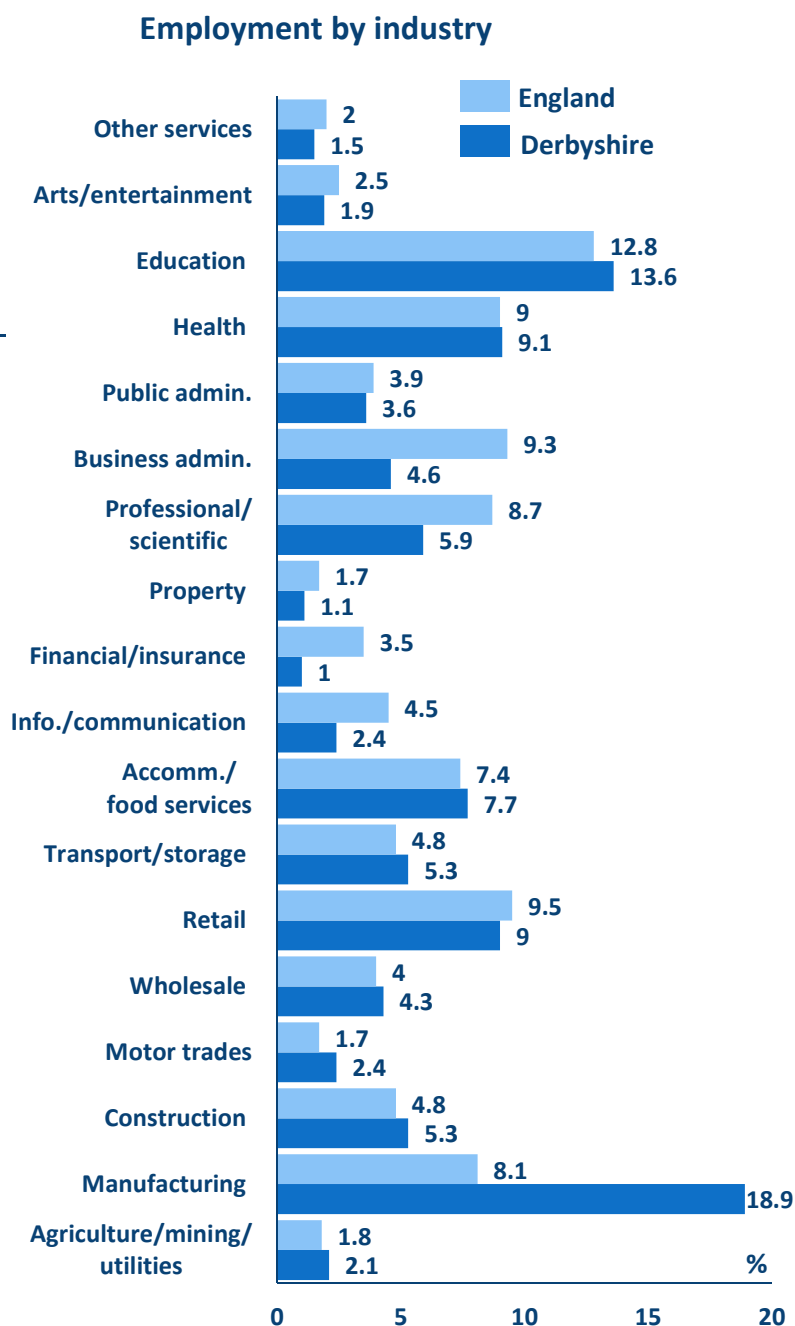
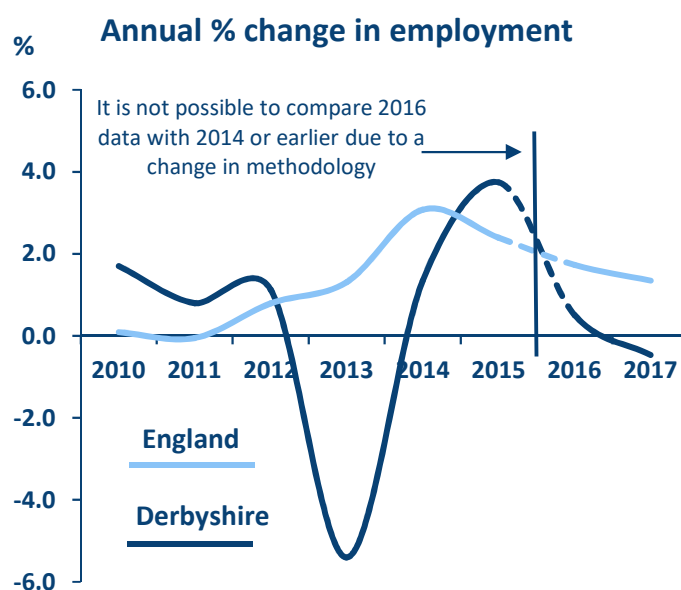


Employment in Derbyshire

290,300 employees in Derbyshire in 2017



There has been a slight decline in employees (-1,400) since 2016, led by a decline in the business administration and retail sectors. However, there has been strong growth in accommodation and food.



Employment growth in the county has dipped marginally in 2017 compared with a slight rise nationally

The dip in employment in 2013 locally was due to the loss of 18,200 public sector jobs, and took employment below that seen after the 2009 recession

Bolsover has experienced large growth (of around 4,600 employees) since 2009, with South Derbyshire and Chesterfield also faring well

However, in Derbyshire Dales there has been a drop of more than 2,600 employees since 2009, due to a fall in public sector employment in the district
