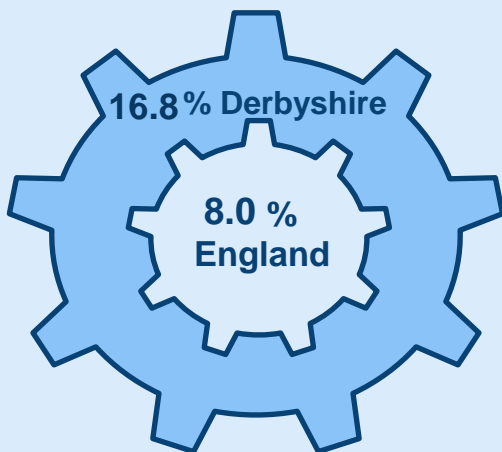


Manufacturing in Derbyshire

Manufacturing was Derbyshire's largest sector in 2018 employing

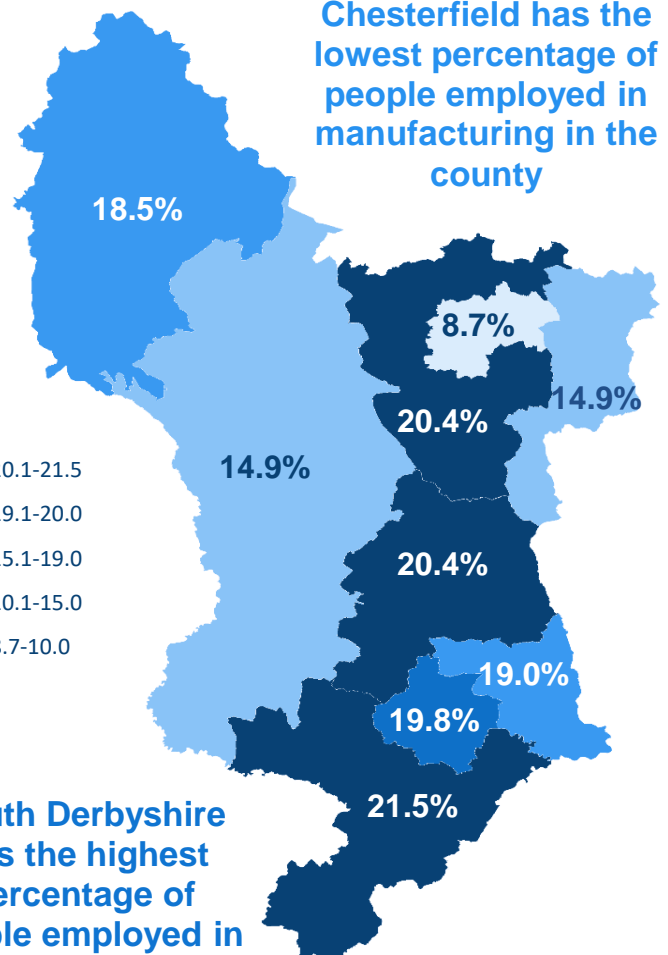
49,500 people

This represents one sixth of the county's workforce, more than double the national average



Over the last year the number of manufacturing jobs in the county has decreased by 5,500 employees. The greatest decreases were in Amber Valley and Bolsover

Chesterfield has the lowest percentage of people employed in manufacturing in the county



South Derbyshire has the highest percentage of people employed in manufacturing

The county has strength in **medium high tech manufacturing**, with many products feeding firms at the top of the supply chain, such as Rolls Royce, Toyota, Bombardier and JCB

The largest manufacturing sub-sectors in the county are **food and drink manufacturing** and **metals and metal products**. Since 2013 **wood products and furniture manufacturing** has seen the greatest growth (650 jobs) whilst the **manufacture of textiles and clothing** has seen the greatest
