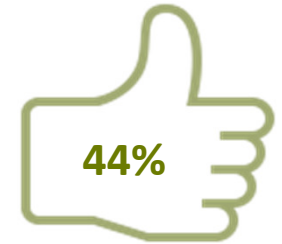
69% of respondents are confident that recycling is turned into new materials

Percentage of respondents who felt safe when....

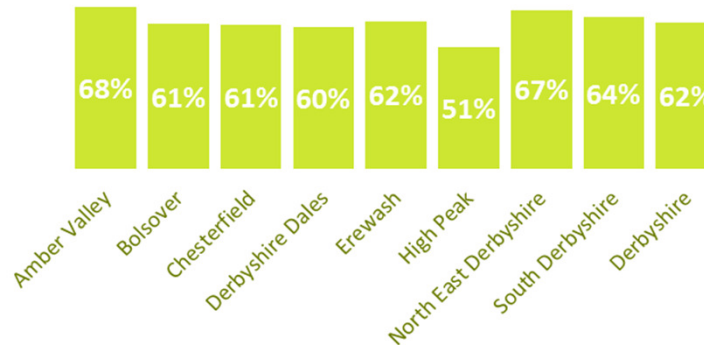
96% outside in their local area during the day
