

Derbyshire Citizens' Panel and Residents Survey Headline Results - March 2019

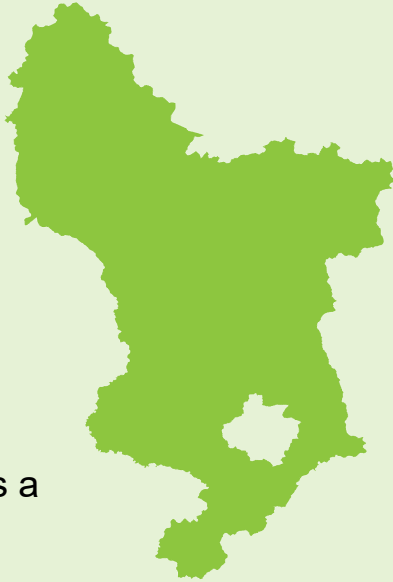
4335 residents responded to the survey questions relating to the local area, social networks, volunteering, community safety, transport, recycling, the Council, and equalities.

Local Area:

80% are proud of Derbyshire

86% are satisfied with their local area

75% think Derbyshire is a safe place to live
