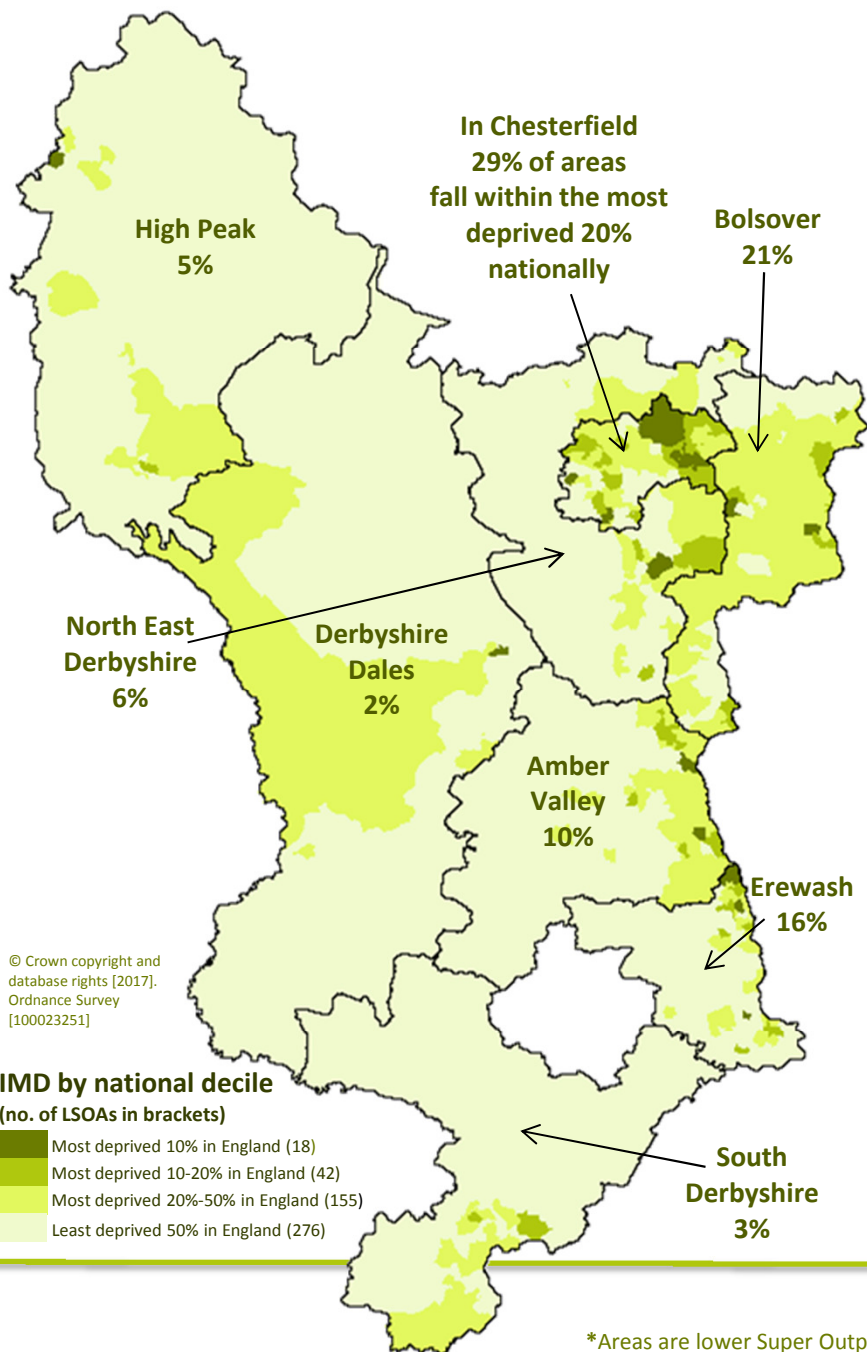


What we know about deprivation in Derbyshire in 2015



Part of **Cotmanhay** in Erewash is the **most deprived area*** in Derbyshire

Part of **Simmondley** in High Peak is the **least deprived area** in Derbyshire



18 areas (4%) within Derbyshire fall within the **10% most deprived areas** across England

60 areas (12%) in the county fall within the most deprived 20%

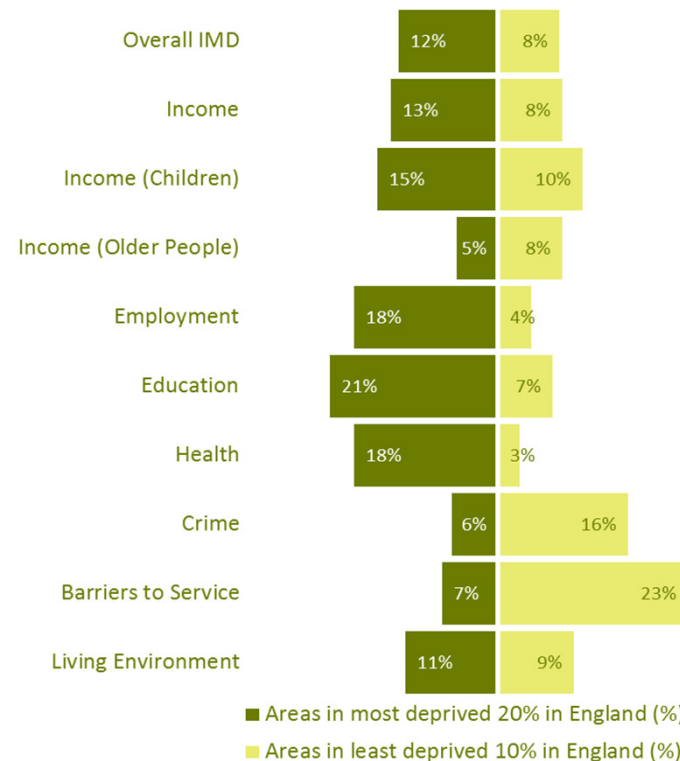


17% of children in Derbyshire live in income deprived households

14% of older people in Derbyshire live in low income households



Deprivation by domain



The **Education** domain has **greatest** percentage of areas within the most deprived 20% nationally at **21%** (102 areas)

The **Employment and Health** domains have the second highest percentage of areas within the most deprived 20% nationally at **18%** for each (87 areas)
