

Homelessness in Derbyshire - 2021

3.9% of households are defined as homeless, and 3.2% households are classed as threatened with homelessness

2558 households are determined to be either homeless or at risk of homelessness



Since 2020, 527 less households are threatened with homelessness, and 99 more households are classed as homeless

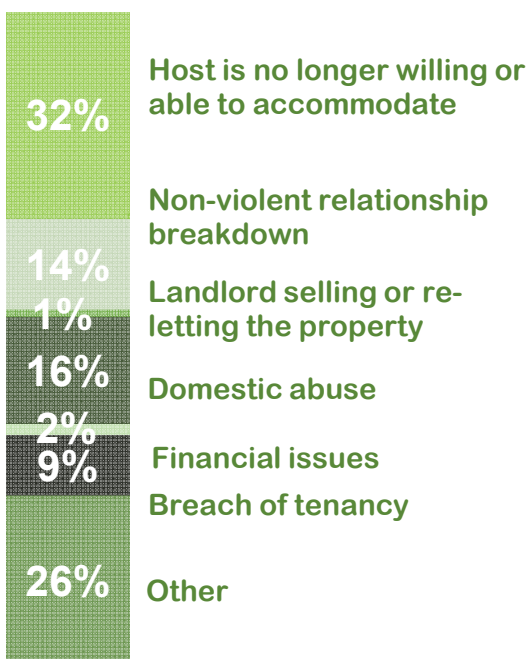


60% of those homeless or at risk have dependant children, and 79% of these are lone parents

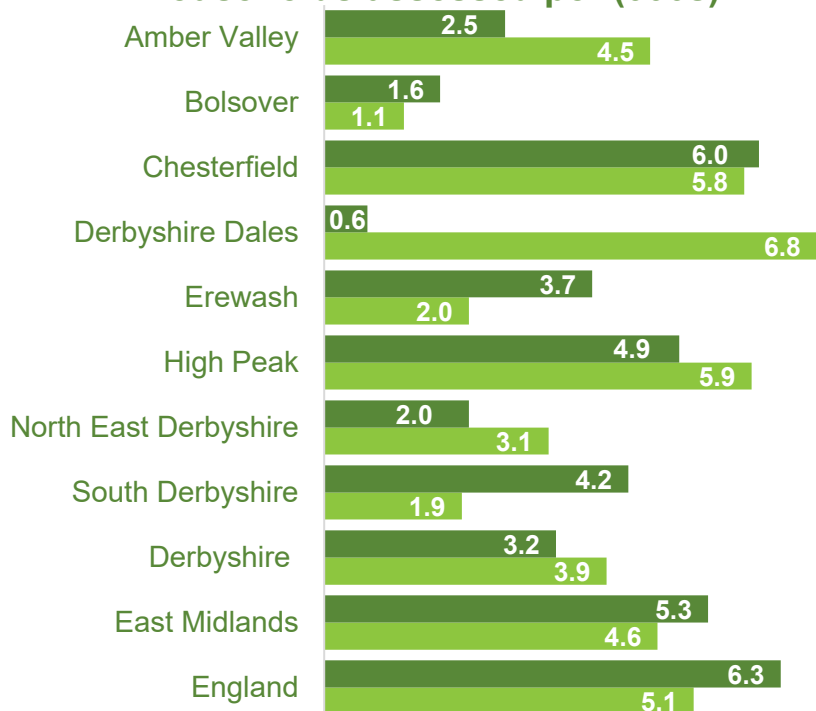
There are 107 rough sleepers, costing local councils £2,154,000 a year

55% of homeless or at risk households have vulnerable individuals of which:

- 791** have a history of mental health problems
- 347** are physically ill or disabled
- 320** have experienced or at risk of domestic abuse
- 260** have a drug and/or alcohol dependency
- 91** are aged 16-25
- 60** are care leavers
- 36** have experienced or at risk of sexual abuse/exploitation
