

Homelessness in Derbyshire - 2019

1.3% of households are defined as homeless and 0.8% are classed as threatened with homelessness

751 households are either homeless or at risk of homelessness



Since 2018, 108 more households are threatened with homelessness and 20 more households are classed as homeless



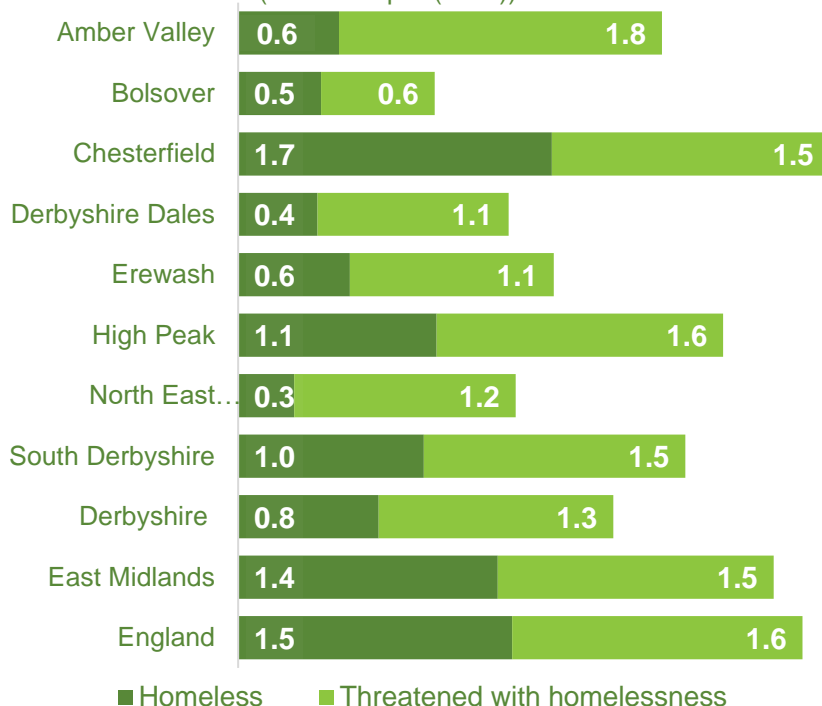
36% of those homeless or at risk have dependant children, and 79% of these are lone parents

14 rough sleepers cost local councils £282,000 a year

55% of homeless or at risk households have vulnerable individuals of which:

- 24** have a history of mental health problems
- 137** are physically ill or disabled
- 96** have experienced or at risk of domestic abuse
- 41** have a drug and/or alcohol dependency
- 28** are aged 16-25
- 20** are care leavers
- 13** have experienced or at risk of sexual abuse/exploitation
