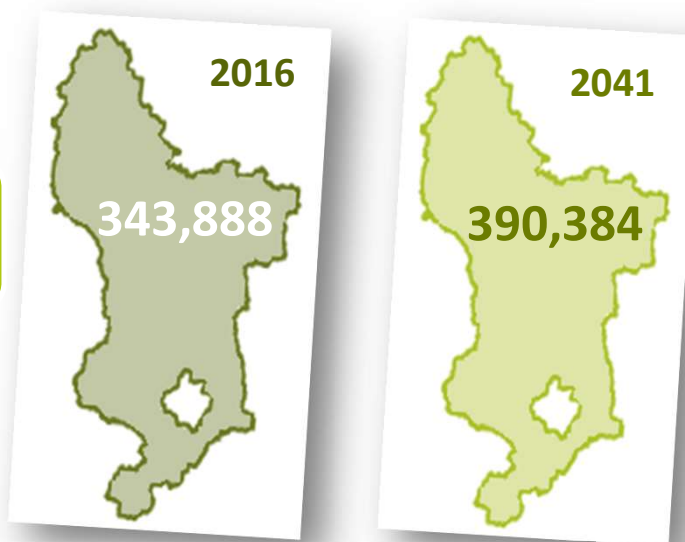


How are Derbyshire's households expected to change over the next 25 years?

Increase in Total Households 2016 - 2041



Derbyshire's average household size is expected to fall from 2.26 in 2016 to 2.13 in 2041.

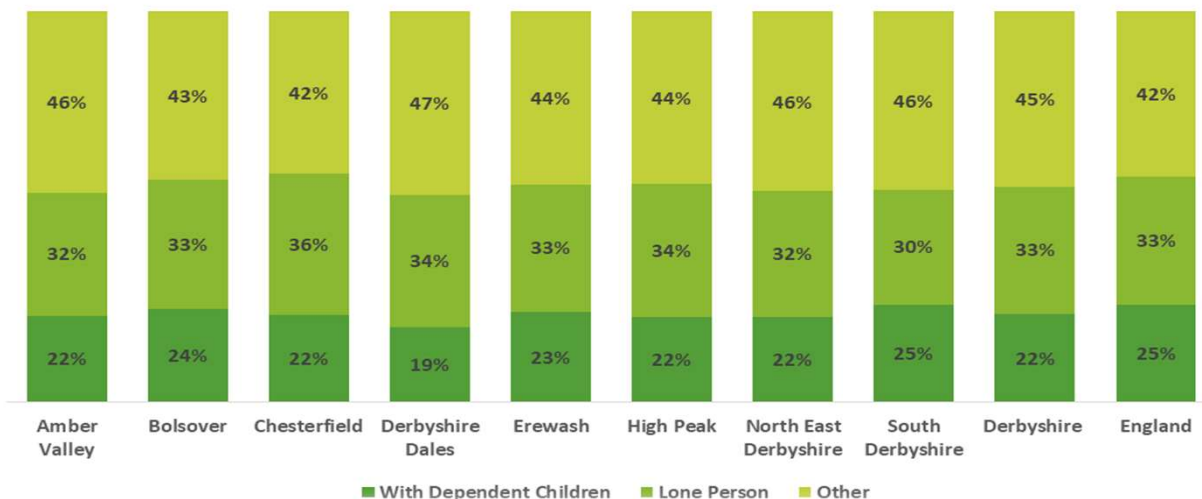


By 2041 the number of households is expected to increase by a further 46,500 (13.5%).

In 2016 the number of households had increased by 10,800 since 2011 (3.2%).

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2041 Predicted Household Types



Derbyshire households with dependent children will fall from 26% in 2016 to 22% in 2041.



Derbyshire households with lone adults will rise from 29% in 2016 to 32% by 2041.
