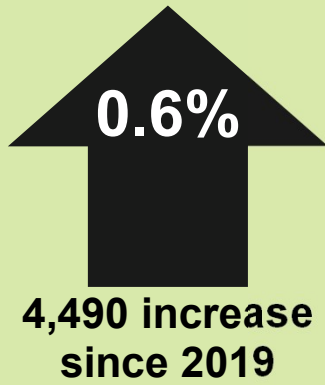


Derbyshire's Population - 2020

103.6 females

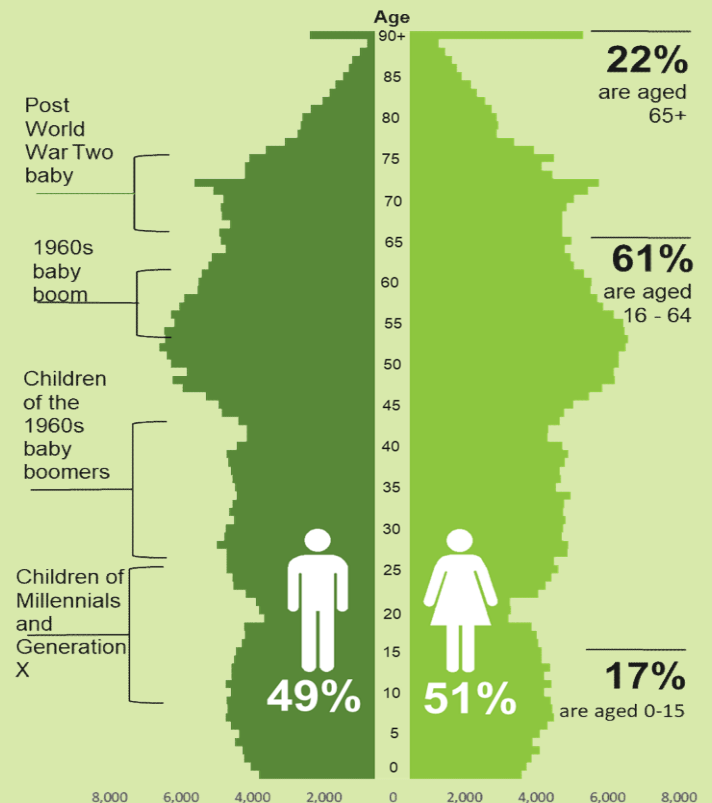


Dependency

There are **64 dependents** (population aged 0-15 and 65 years and over) per 100 of the working-age population aged 16-64 years. This has increased by 6.7 dependents since 2001, widening the gap with England.
