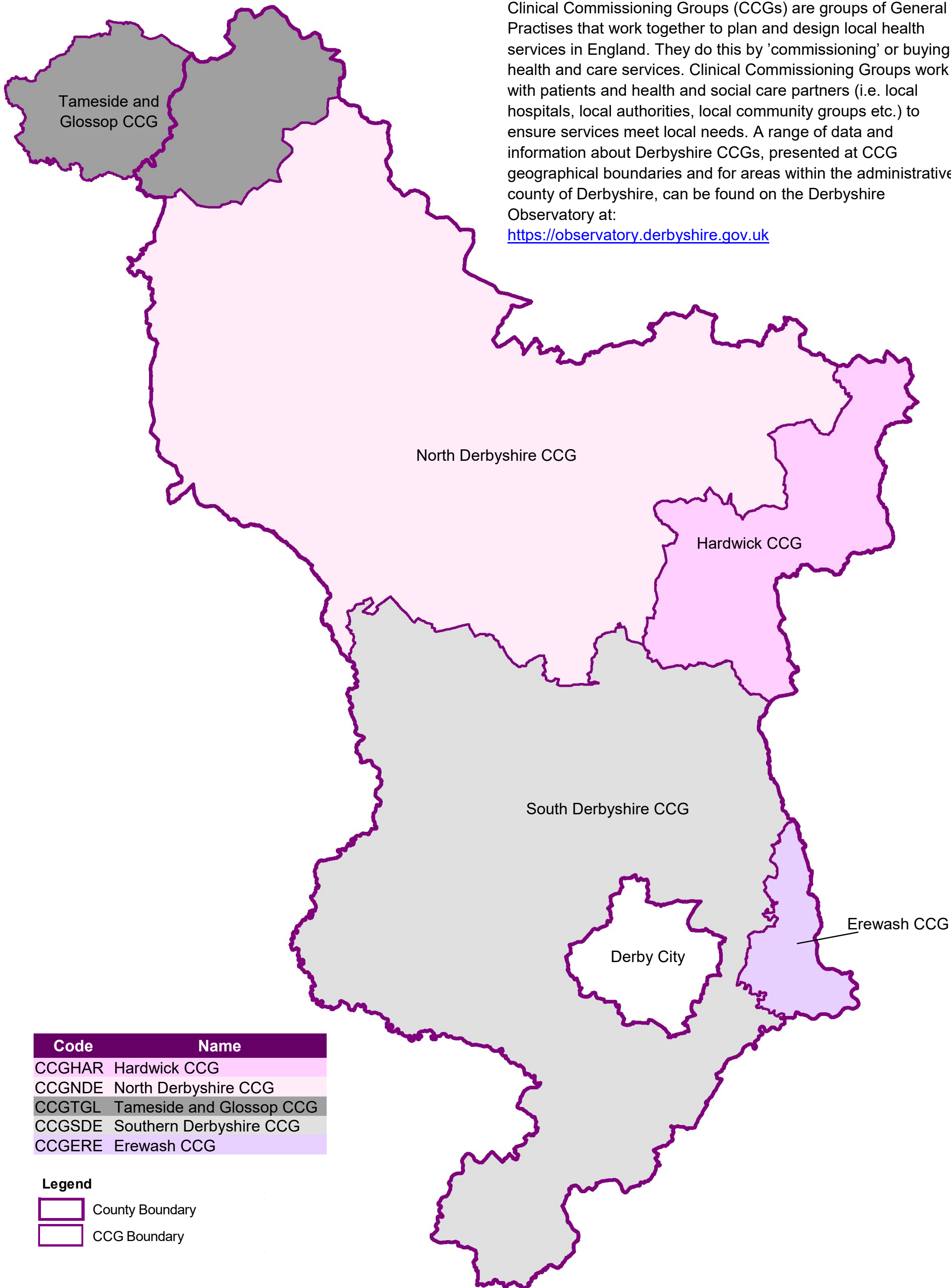


Derbyshire Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) 2011



Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) are groups of General Practises that work together to plan and design local health services in England. They do this by 'commissioning' or buying health and care services. Clinical Commissioning Groups work with patients and health and social care partners (i.e. local hospitals, local authorities, local community groups etc.) to ensure services meet local needs.
