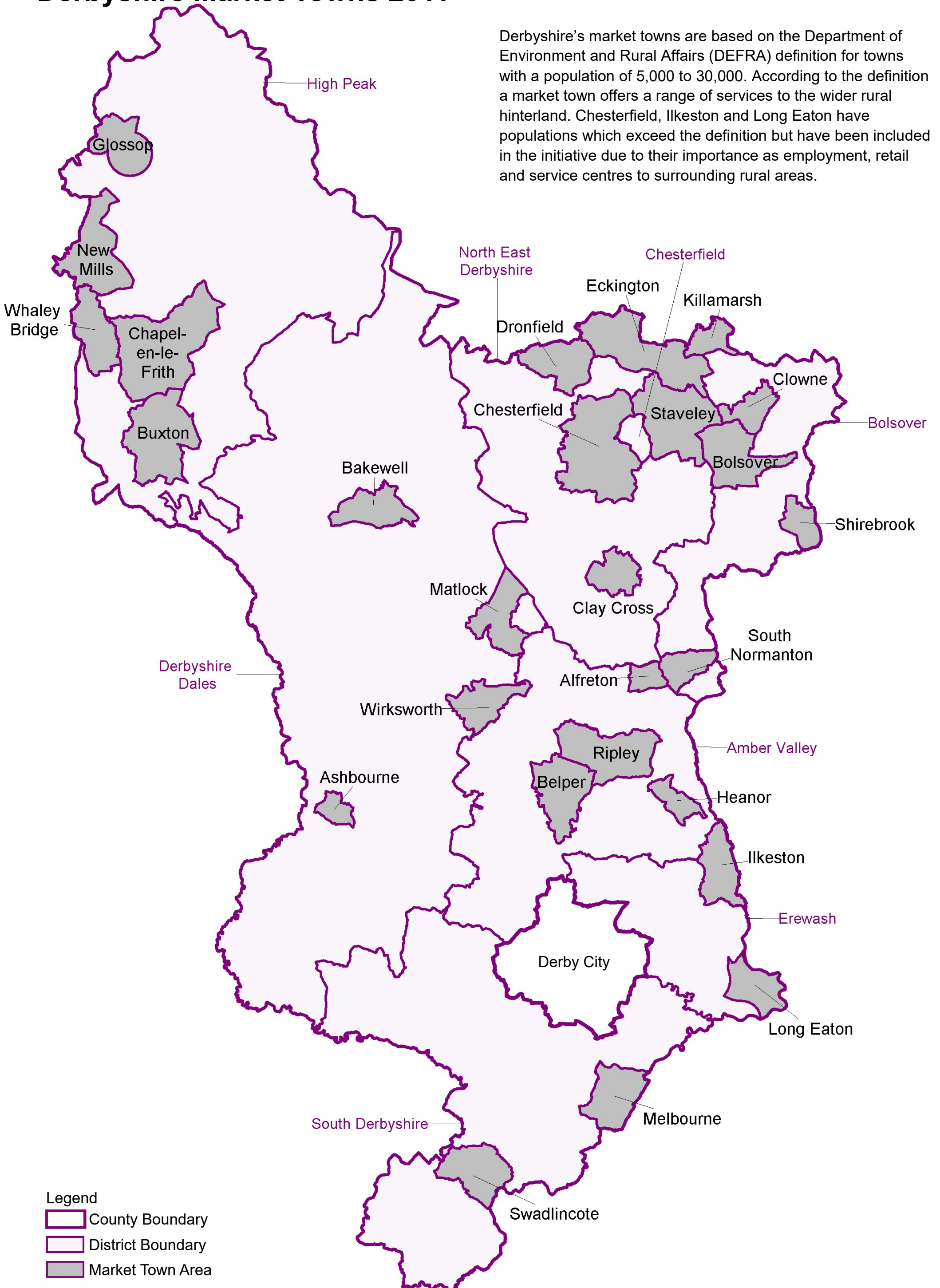


Derbyshire Market Towns 2011

Derbyshire's market towns are based on the Department of Environment and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) definition for towns with a population of 5,000 to 30,000. According to the definition a market town offers a range of services to the wider rural hinterland. Chesterfield, Ilkeston and Long Eaton have populations which exceed the definition but have been included in the initiative due to their importance as employment, retail and service centres to surrounding rural areas.
