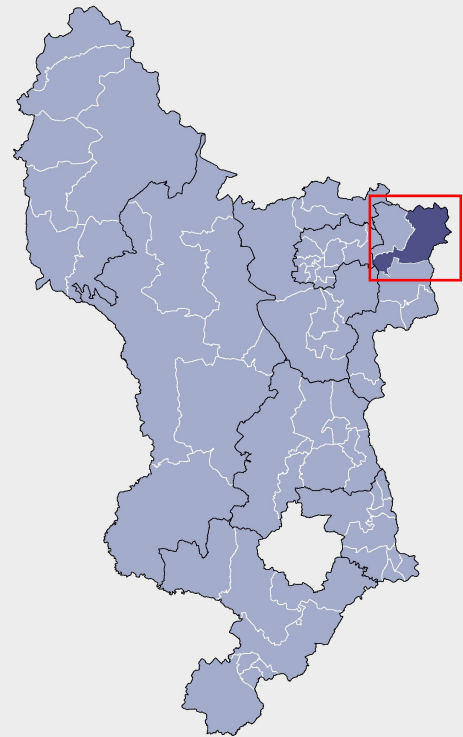
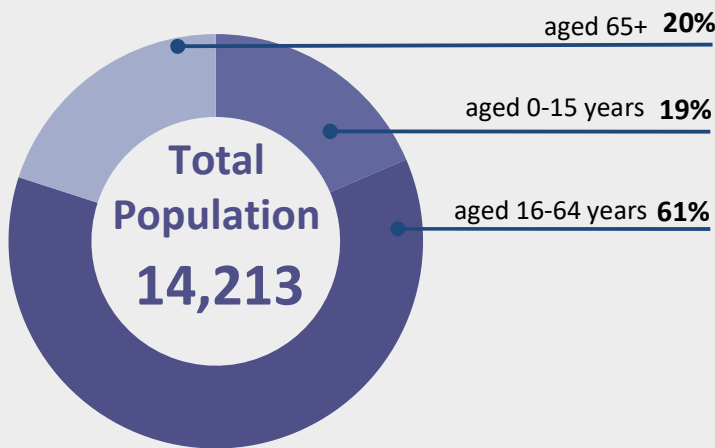


2023 Area Summary Profile Bolsover North Electoral Division

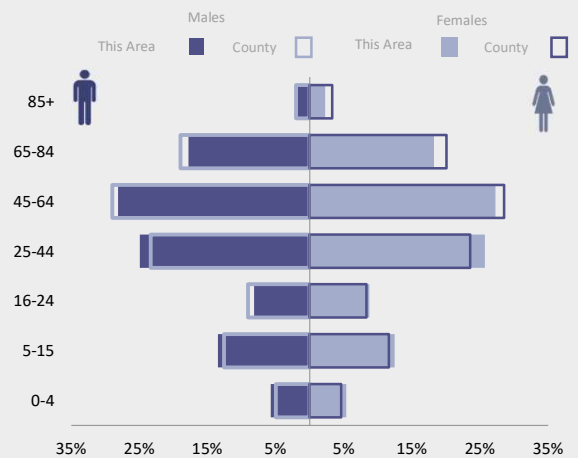

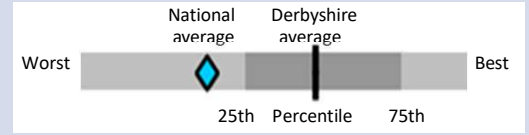

The chart below compares a range of indicators for Derbyshire.
