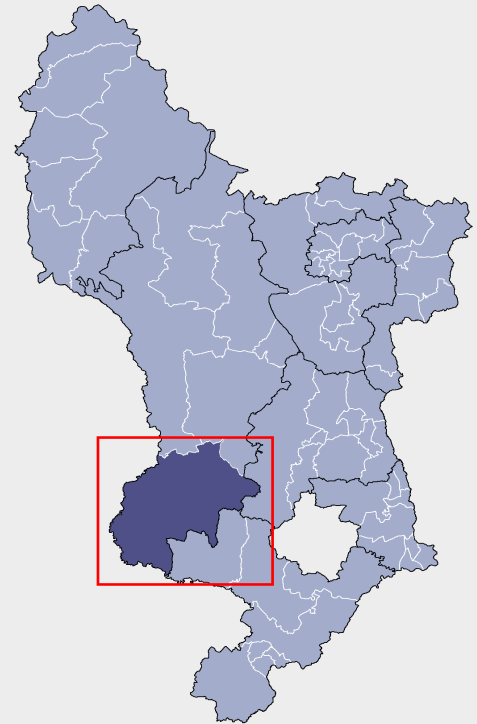
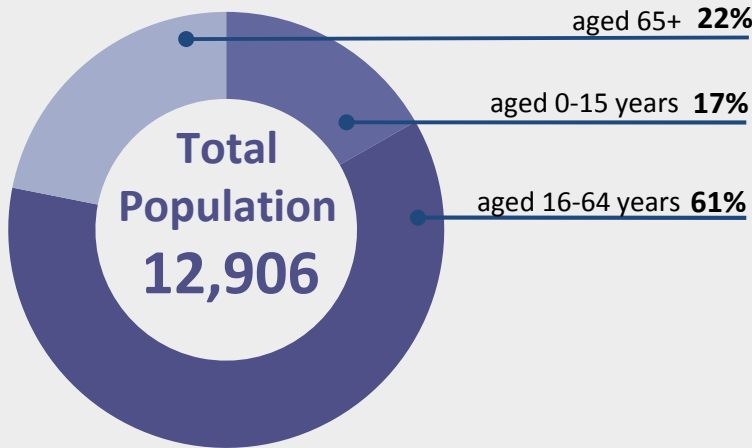


2018 Area Summary Profile Ashbourne Electoral Division

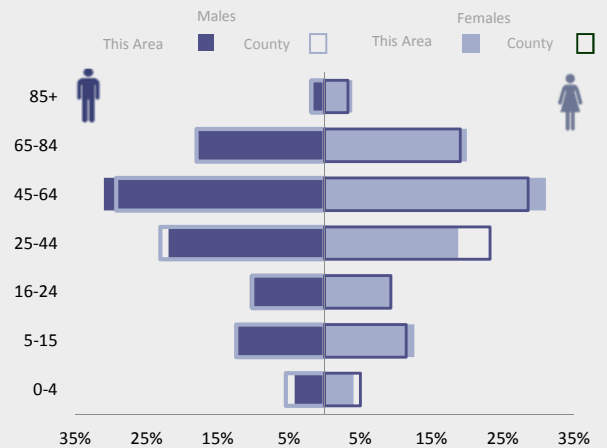

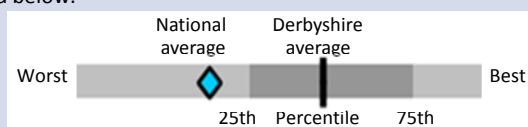
2018 Area Summary Profile

Ashbourne Electoral Division



The chart below compares a range of indicators for Derbyshire.
