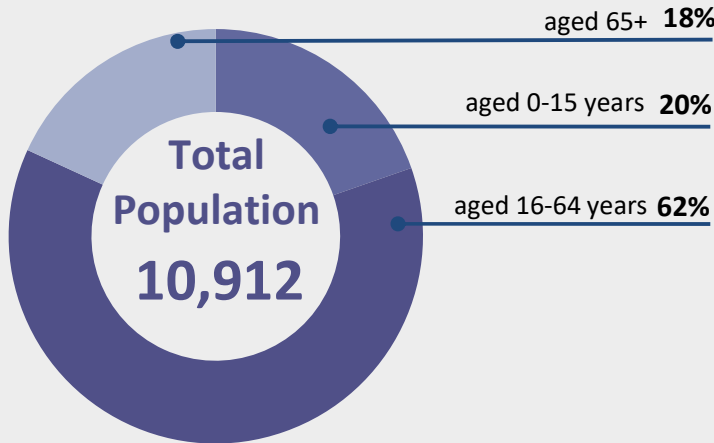
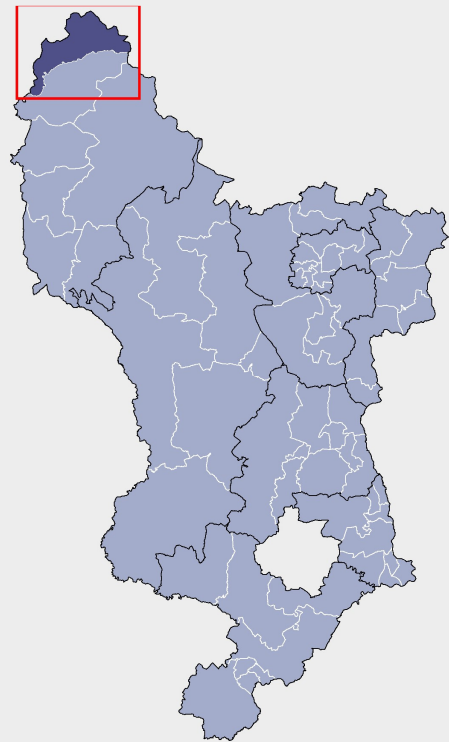


2023 Area Summary Profile Etherow Electoral Division

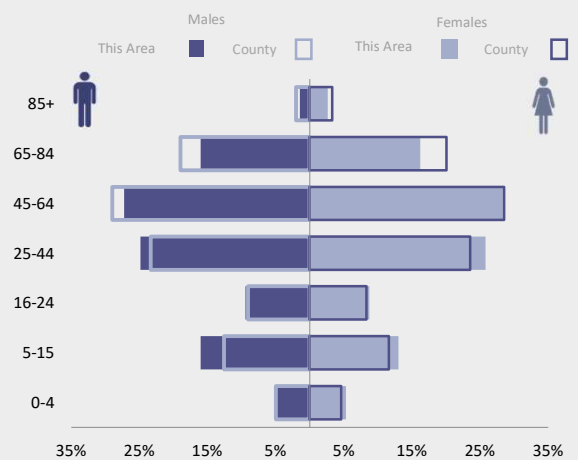

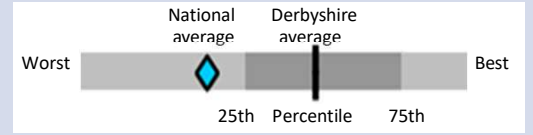
